Southeastern Fisheries Association is exempt from federal income tax under the provisions of Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code. Membership dues paid to the Association are not deductible as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes. However, dues payments by members are deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense, subject to limitations resulting from the Association's lobbying activities. Southeastern Fisheries Association estimates that the nondeductible portion of your dues allocable to lobbying is 5%.
